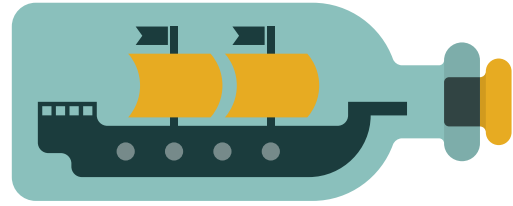


# A VERY TINY BOAT



## 1. Set Up.

Set up 2 rows of chairs. The rows should face each other.



Ask team members to find a seat and hold hands with the person across from them (if they're comfortable doing so).

## 2. The Activity.

Partner 1: For the next 50 seconds tell the person across from you things that you want to know about them.

Partner 2: Don't answer the questions or talk. Just sit and listen to your partner.

*(Have the partners rotate by asking one row of chairs to move in one direction. Repeat this a few times. Make sure everyone gets a chance to listen and talk a few times.)*

## 3. Debrief.

- Were you surprised by what people wanted to know about you?
- How did it feel to be the listener? The questioner?
- Were you overwhelmed by the intimacy of this activity? Did it intimidate you? Can you imagine someone who might be intimidated by this activity?
- How does this apply to welcoming campers or staff to camp?
