Suggested Directions

- 1. Print flashcards on cardstock (regular paper works too)
- 2. Cut and laminate flashcards
- 3. Punch hole in top left corner of each card
- 4. Put a keyring through the hole (or zip tie, string, etc.) to keep flashcards together
 - a. You can make multiple key ring sets of the flashcards to hand out to your leadership staff if you'd like to debrief in small groups
- 5. The key rings can be passed around to counselors to choose their debrief question, or the leadership staff member can select which questions to ask the whole group
- 6. There is a blank template attached at the end if you'd like to create your own debrief questions

Who is your best camp parent? Why?

What were the best things about this summer's staff?

Are you personally satisfied with your summer? Why or why not?

What is your proudest accomplishment from the summer? In what ways did you grow or change as a leader this summer?

What are you going to do differently for next summer?

What was something new you tried this summer? How did it go? How was this summer at your camp different from previous summers? Tell me about an emergency you dealt with this summer. What is the biggest regret you have from this summer?

Talk about a staff member you connected with this summer. Tell me about your boss. What would you change about them? Did staff members perform to your expectations this summer?

In what ways were you most prepared for this summer? Least prepared?

What was the most surprising thing about this year's campers?

Who was your favorite staff member? Why?

Did you have the support you needed this summer? Why or why not?

What was the biggest strength of your camp this summer?

What were the most challenging things about this summer's staff?

What were new camper issues you encountered this summer? What was the biggest weakness of your camp this summer?

Which camp experiences did campers enjoy the most?

Did campers enjoy their time at your camp? Why or why not?

What is a lesson you learned this summer?

What was your biggest personal challenge this summer?

What were parents like this summer?

What is something you didn't understand this summer? Tell me about a controversy you dealt with this summer. Talk about a camper you connected with this summer. Were any campers "sent home early" from your camp? What happened?

What is your reflection from staff training this summer? When was there a culture of abundance at your camp?

When was there a culture of scarcity at your camp? Who is your most challenging camp parent? Why?

What was your biggest professional challenge this summer? Tell me about a skill you gained or enhanced this summer.
